



POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT On-Call Mental Health Professional Residential Services

Purpose:

This on-call position is responsible to answer inquires for IRTS/crisis stabilization services, 24 hours a day.

Required Education and Experience:

The On Call Clinical Supervisor shall be qualified as a Mental Health Professional in at least one of the following ways:

- Master's degree in Counseling, Social Work, or an equivalent field;
- 2 Years post Master's experience providing services to Adults.
- Holds a LICSW, LPCC, LMFT

Preferred:

- 3 years of work experience in psychosocial rehabilitation settings and Clinical experience.

Other Requirements:

- Must be ambulatory and able to negotiate stairways.
- A valid Driver's License, reliable vehicle, satisfactory driving record and necessary insurance.
- Must be able to lift and carry heavy weights that could be up to or even exceed 40 pounds.
- The ability to provide on-call supervision during seven consecutive days and nights.
- Must not be actively receiving services from Guild Incorporated and must not have received services within the last two years.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide direction to the IRTS/Crisis staff to ensure effective and efficient operations of the residential treatment and crisis stabilization services in accordance with licensing requirements and Evidence Based Practices.
- Provide On-Call Clinical Supervision to the Intensive Residential Treatment Services and Crisis Services.
- Ensure services are documented in individual records so information is readily available, results of services can be determined, and record-keeping standards can be met.
- Ensure staff training and requirements are met in accordance with state licensing regulations.
